



# DIMINISHED PULLOFFS OVER E7

## QUICK GUITAR LICKS

### Need a great fingerstyle lick over an E7? Here you go!

This lick works great over an E7 approaching an Am as in a minor ii-V-i.

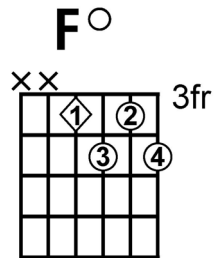
In Am, a ii-V-I progression would be Bm7(b5) – E7 – Am.

This lick uses an Fdim7 chord as its basis. Start by forming an Fdim7 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> position.

An Fdim7 (F-G#-B-D) shares most of the same tones as an E7b9 (E-G#-B-D-F).

Next, with your fourth finger pull off the first string to the open first string E.

Remember, diminished chords can be repeated every three frets.



Another idea is to elaborate the pattern as shown below descending down.
